What is pétanque?

Pétanque, pronounced *pay-tonk*, is a relative of horseshoes and Italian bocce. The game originated in France in the early 1900's. The aim is to toss steel balls as close as possible to a small wooden aim ball. The team which ends up closest to the aim ball wins. Pétanque is often played while enjoying RICARD pastis, so it is no wonder this game is gaining popularity!
